



RED MONEY ENVELOPE

Red envelopes, known as "hóngbāo" in Mandarin, are traditionally given during Lunar New Year in Chinese culture as a symbol of good luck and prosperity. These envelopes contain money and are typically presented to younger family members by their elders, symbolising the transfer of fortune and blessings for the upcoming year.

YOU WILL NEED

- The red envelope template below
- Scissors
- Glue stick
- Gold pen or stickers for decoration
- Money

- 1 Cut out the envelope below.
- 2 Fold in both sides of the red envelope and use the glue stick to seal shut.
- 3 Fold up the bottom and use the glue stick to seal shut.
- 4 Fold over the top and make a crease, but leave it open to put money inside.
- 5 Decorate the front of your envelope.
