clutch	●	● Broad grassy plains of south-western Russia and Central Asia
colonies	●	● Groups of similar animals that live together.

larvae	●	● Land such as marshes and swamps where the ground is always wet.
monogamous	●	● Large, flat, treeless plains of the arctic regions of Europe, Asia and North America.
poaching	●	● Multiple eggs laid at the same time in the same nest.
pollinate	●	● The area where an animal such as fish, crabs or frogs spawns.
spawn	●	● The infant form of insects, amphibians or crustaceans such as dragonflies, crabs and frogs.
spawning grounds	●	● The process of fertilising plants with pollen.
steppes	●	● Tiny crustaceans eaten by whales.
tundra	●	● To hunt, trap or fish without permission.
wetlands	●	● To produce a large number of eggs directly into water.
