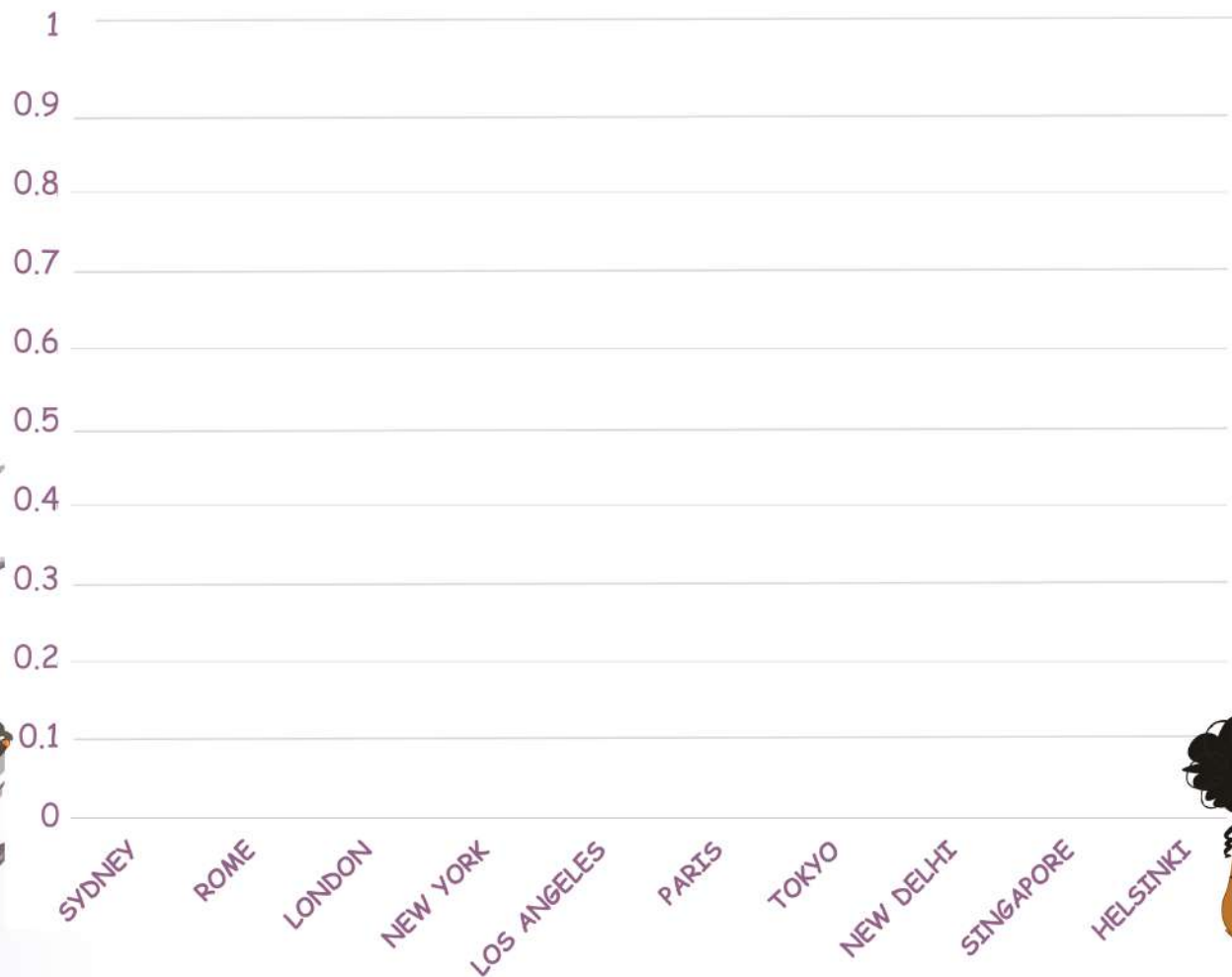


HOMELESSNESS STATISTICS
