

# A MATHS 'N' MOVEMENT CARD ACTIVITY

Bea does not like wearing shoes but when she does she always manages to wear a pair of the same shoes. Print the cards and use them to play memory or the game below.

## YOU WILL NEED

- The cards below printed onto cardboard and cut out.
- A group of at least 14 children.

## ACTIVITY

- 1 Distribute the cards between students - keeping three for yourself. Stand in the middle of the circle and hold up your shoe card.
- 2 Children with that shoe must use the given fundamental movement skill to move into the middle of the circle and find a partner to make a pair of shoes.
- 3 As one student will be partnered with you they must remain in the centre.
- 4 Swap that student's card for a new shoe which they hold up for the next round.
- 5 Students with this new shoe must move to the centre and find a pair. The student who was with you can rush to find a partner and a new student joins you.
- 6 Repeat the process of swapping their card, calling a new Fundamental Movement Skill and students finding pairs.

Performs fundamental movement skills in a variety of situations.



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
